

Overworked and underresourced, middle manager Benjamin Toh is tasked with taking care of the supernatural occurrences and people no one else wants to deal with.




### <u>Detour</u> by Jeff Rake

A space shuttle flight crew discovers that the Earth they've returned to is not the home they left behind.




### If I Ruled the World by Amy Barnett

Nikki Rose has six months to save struggling hip hop music and lifestyle magazine, Sugar, and her dreams.




### Rifle Season by Pat Kelly


#### <u>Family Drama</u> by Rebecca Fallon


### This Book Made Me Think of You by Libby Page

Over the course of two decades, a group of lifelong friends explore the growing pains of life, love, and getting older.




### <u>Saoirse</u> by Charleen Hurtubise

After winning unexpected acclaim at a Dublin exhibition, an artist's traumatic past threatens to return as unwanted publicity forces her into the spotlight.




### Shut Up and Read by Jeannine Cook

Jeannine Cook chronicles the improbable true story of how she left an abusive past to build a bookshop that survived the Covid pandemic and became an international sensation.




# How to Get Away with Murder by Rebecca Philipson


### <u>Frida's Cook</u> by Florencia Etcheves

A young cook forms a friendship with Frida Kahlo in 1939 Mexico City, leaving behind secrets that her granddaughter uncovers through a mysterious painting.




### Wait For Me by Amy Burns

From sleepy mountain towns to the bright lights of Nashville, two folk singers share an unexpected bond over past loves and the music that brings them together.




### <u>Shock of the Light</u> <u>by Lori Hall</u>

ensure he follows orders.




### Cleo Dang Would Rather be Dead by Mai Nguyen

Trying to navigate life after the loss of her baby, Cleo Dang finds a job at a funeral home and discovers the power of confronting your grief head on.




### <u>This Kingdom Will Not</u> Kill Me by Ilona Andrews

Maggie wakes up in the fantasy world of a series she's been obsessively reading, and she must use her encyclopedic knowledge to keep her beloved characters alive.




### <u>This Vast Empire</u> by Craig Fehrman

A major revisionist history of the Lewis and Clark expedition offering a fresh and more accurate account of one of the most important episodes in American history.




#### All Carry by Gene Wojciechowski

A recently laid-off golf reporter and a down-onhis-luck caddie set out to do the impossible: win the Masters as an amateur.




### <u>Liars Creek</u> by Matt Goldman
