ELKTON — After 38 years, the Elkton branch of Cecil County Public Library is getting a facelift and public input is being sought at a Jan. 29 community meeting. Starting at 6:30 representatives from Quinn Evans Architects charged with re-imagining the branch at 301 Newark Avenue will meet with people interested in what should be included. Both systems and spaces will be the topics of discussion. This is your chance to have a say in what the Elkton Branch should become. No registration is required. The Elkton branch underwent \$297,500 in renovations in 2011 for the administrative spaces, which have since been moved to the newer North East Branch Library, which opened in 2021.
