Cecil County Public Library is developing a new service partnership with the Town of Port Deposit and local non-profit Community Connecting Us (CCU). Is the Port Deposit Library Closed for Good?

The library is not renewing the lease for the building at 13 South Main Street, where the library has been located for years. However, the Library is partnering with Community Connecting Us to provide Library services at their campus located at 99 North Main Street.

What is Community Connecting Us (CCU)?

A local non-profit focused on the community needs of Port Deposit. It is a separate entity from the Library, but by partnering, their campus buildings provide spaces for The Library to provide services and programs.

What Library Services are currently being offered?

The Library is currently offering a weekly StoryTime, STEM and other learning programs for youth, bookmobile visits, and co-sponsors the Port Deposit Bike Project.

As the partnership formalizes and planning moves into the fall, the Library will continue expanding services such as access to public computers and Wifi, Librarian assistance, and Job Help with the Library's tech-mobile, both at CCU and throughout the town.
