

Library Announces Expanded Hours Starting Monday, October 3

North East, MD. Cecil County Public Library will increase hours at the Cecilton, Chesapeake City, Perryville and Rising Sun Branches starting Monday, October 3.

These additional hours will create greater access for the community for meeting rooms, programs, and critical library services- especially for students and those who work during the day.

The Elkton and North East Branches will maintain the same operating schedule at this time, due to staffing shortages. An assessment of both branches' operating status will occur later this year.

“Recent budget increases have allowed us to increase staffing levels, making these additional hours possible, and we thank the County Administration for the support,” stated Executive Director Morgan Miller. “We will continue to work together to resolve current staffing and funding gaps so that the library system can be fully open to the community.”

Citizens' vocal and written support of the Library played a large part in showing the community's need for expanded Library access.
