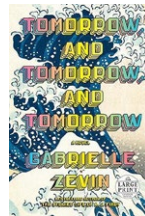
Jack Brubaker, author of *Conestogas: On the Trail of the Paxton Boys in Lancaster County*, will discuss the Conestogas and
